


# Ganesh Haloi | Ram Kumar



- Ganesh Haloi, born in 1936 in Jamalpur, Bangladesh, is a highly acclaimed artist with a distinguished career. He pursued his education at the Government College of Art and Craft in Kolkata from 1952 to 1956, further enriching his artistic journey.
- Haloi's art has evolved from pure landscapes to abstract "innerscapes," reflecting a profound transformation in his artistic style.
- Haloi's unforgettable nature-scapes encapsulate life's irregular movements within artificial boundaries. Haloi's tranquil perspective, infused with philosophy, adds profound depth to his work.







Ganesh Haloi's works touch upon every aspect of his life, from childhood memories of the lush green lands of his birthplace in East Bengal to episodes of violence and displacement. Haloi's works are heavily coded, where geometrical elements like lines and triangles signify not only the topography of agricultural lands but also the world's cartographical complexities.





- Ram Kumar, born in 1924 in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh, stands as one of India's foremost abstract painters.
- Ram Kumar's artistic expression is akin to long poems, inviting viewers to explore the layered meanings beneath the surface. Influenced by accumulated memories, particularly his association with the holy city of Varanasi.
- Ram Kumar freely draws upon subconscious images and fond memories, etched deep into his subconscious.

to the cognitive Devoted and topographical mapping of the city of Varanasi, emerged from Ram Kumar's visit to the city in the 1960s. In this piece, one can notice acts of masking and erasures, suggesting the immateriality of memory, often fleeting, hazy, and ephemeral. Kumar's sensibility towards moods is prolific, whereas his tendency for a process-based practice is evident in compositions abundant with visual metaphors, transcendental in expression yet grounded with artistic vocabulary.

Ram Kumar's transition from figurative painting in his early career to abstract landscape was seamless. Yet the absence of the human figure unravels the cycle of life and death - presence and absence bound together. In this piece, the city is represented through generic box-shaped forms, all wedged together, wrestling for space on the crowded riverbank, capturing the essence of the narrow lanes, chaotic architecture, and serenity of the holy river that flows through the city of Banaras.




The overall mood of the painting is melancholic and is infused with a feeling of tension and despair. Kumar's works are abundant with visual metaphors, transcendental in expression yet grounded in artistic vocabulary. This work is full of hidden meanings; one can sense a form in the middle of the composition eerily gazing at the viewer. Kumar strategically places warmer vermillion to make this piece more dynamic.
